
What is the Centennial Circle?

What does the Centennial Circle fund?

Centennial Circle Members provide vital funds to sustain our ability to preserve, enhance, and share the Parthenon and Centennial Park. These mission-critical annual funds ensure we are able to engage 500,000 people through accessible community programming and serve the 3 million annual visitors who enjoy the park each year.

Public Green Space

We collaborate with Metro Parks to identify, fund, and address ongoing maintenance and preservation needs in **Centennial Park**, improving the community green space for present and future generations.

Enviroment

We inspire positive environmental change at **Nashville Earth Day**, the city's official Earth Day celebration.

Art

We fund compelling art exhibitions, engaging lectures, and unique performances in the **Parthenon** museum for 350K visitors each year.





Music

We provide access to free community music events and showcase artists at **Musicians Corner** for 75K people annually.

Education

We support families by presenting 100 free educational children's events through **Kidsville** in Centennial Park and Metro Community Centers.
